2 24-03-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Section 310(2) of
the BNS, 2023

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has antecedent of two cases and the informant alleges
that six named accused came to the informant on 05.10.2025 at
05:20 PM and looted Rs. 4,50,000/- and fled.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR
is against unknown and one Chandan was identified based on
CCTV footage and was apprehended and he disclosed the name
of petitioner as one of an accused who participated in loot. It is
further submitted that confessional statement of apprehended



accused in police custody which does not have any evidentiary value.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the anticipatory bail application of the petitioner and submits that no doubt confessional statement does not have any evidentiary value in the eyes of law, but then petitioner has antecedent of two cases and Chandan was identified based on CCTV footage and based on his disclosure, the name of the petitioner transpired. It is next submitted that if privilege of anticipatory bail is granted, the petitioner may abscond or try to tamper with the evidence, since he has antecedents.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned APP for the State, the Court is not inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, the instant anticipatory bail application stands rejected.
