Learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners are apprehending arrest in connection with Mashrakh P.S. Case No.110 of 2025 lodged on 15.03.2025, for the offences punishable under Sections 80, 102, 62 and 3(5) of the B.N.S., 2023.

3. As per the prosecution, FIR has been lodged against four named accused persons including the present petitioners against whom there is allegation that they in connivance with each other beaten the victim when she caught illicit relationship with his brother's wife. Upon assault, she becomes unconscious and died.



4. Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence. Counsel also submits that petitioners are brother-in-law and sister-in-law of the victim. The allegation made against the petitioners is general and omnibus. He further submits that the petitioners are living separately and have no concern with the life of victim and her husband. Only being a relative, the petitioners were being made accused in this case.

5. Counsel further submits that the bail application of the husband of the victim has been rejected by this Court vide order dated 25.03.2026 passed in Cr. Misc. No.15727 of 2026.

6. Counsel submits that the criminal antecedent of the petitioners is clean.

7. Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioners.

8. As such, in the present facts and circumstances of this case, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 4 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand) each as mentioned in Section 2(1)(d) of the BNSS, 2023 to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M.-7th, Saran at Chapra in connection with



Mashrak P.S. Case No.110 of 2025, subject to the conditions as
laid down U/s 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023.
