learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Wazirganj P.S. Case No. 220 of 2014 registered for the offence
under Sections 384, 386, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and
Section 17 of the CLA.

3. The allegation against the petitioner is that he,
along with other co-accused persons who are Naxalites,
demanded extortion money from an employee of the
construction company. On non-fulfillment of the demand, they
threatened the contractor by pasting a pamphlet and also burnt
the JCB machine and tractor belonging to the contractor.

4. The petitioner is in custody since 15.09.2025. The
allegations against the petitioner are serious and grave in nature.



There exists *prima facie* material against the petitioner indicating his involvement in the commission of the offence.

5. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the allegations levelled against the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the application for regular bail stands rejected.

6. It is made clear that any observation made herein is *prima facie* in nature and limited solely for the purpose of adjudication of the present bail application. Such observations shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and shall not influence the trial or any other proceedings in any manner.
