3 26-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 669 dated 10.05.2026 of the

Senior Superintendent of Police, Darbhanga along with the
report of S.H.O., Bahadurpur Police Station dated 05.05.2026,
wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that
the sole appellant Halkhori Ram @ Ram Bilash Ram has died.
Certificate of death of the appellant issued by Up-Pramukh,
Village-Ojhoul, Block-Bahadurpur, District-Darbhanga has also
been enclosed with the said reports.

2. In view of the said letters as also section 394 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to
section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023,
since no near relative has filed any application for leave to
continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and



disposed of.
