3 03-04-2026 Perused the Letter No. 280 dated 15.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Bhojpur along with the Report dated 07.02.2026 of Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O, Bhojpur Police Station as well as the Report dated 07.02.2026 of the Ward Councilor of Ward No. 14 of Nagar Panchayat, Koilwar; wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Chinta Devi, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.



3. Let the trial court record be sent back to the concerned court immediately, if not required in any other cases.
