2 01-04-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 126, 115,
118, 109, 74, 303(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of the BNS, 2023.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and the informant
alleges that on 06.10.2024 at 07:00 PM, accused Lav Kush
Rajvanshi assaulted his wife by *gandasa* causing injury on head
while petitioner assaulted his son by an iron rod (*khanti*) causing
injury on head and Rinki, Pinki along with Reeta assaulted his
daughter-in-law and Pinki snatched her chain.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case by the
informant, it is next submitted that no reason for the occurrence



is alleged. It is also submitted that petitioner and the informant and neighbours and are having dispute relating to passage. It is further submitted that no doubt allegation is of assaulting the son of the informant by *khanti* causing injury on head, but then the injury has been opined to be simple and the blow is not alleged to be repeated and petitioner is not a criminal.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the anticipatory bail application of the petitioner.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Wazirganj P.S. Case No. 753 of 2024 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) of BNSS.

7. Accordingly, the instant anticipatory bail application stands allowed.
