3 20-05-2026 Heard the parties through virtual mode.

2. The petitioner is apprehending arrest in connection with Ujiyarpur P.S. Case No. 363 of 2020 instituted under Section 30(a), 41(1) (2) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act lodged on 06.12.2020 by the informant, Akhil Kumar Singh.

3. As per the prosecution story, the informant alleged that during night patrolling, the motorcycle rider was intercepted. He tried to escape but later, the name was given as Sujit Kumar. The paper of the motorcycle was not produced and there is recovery/seizure of 180 ml. country made foreign liquor. He gave the name of this petitioner as the owner of the vehicle. This led to the FIR.

4. Though, learned counsel for the petitioner tried to



impress about his innocence, learned APP, Mr. Jitendra Kumar Singh submits that the FIR is of the year 2020 and six years later, this anticipatory bail application.

5. Considering the aforesaid submissions of the parties as also the delay in coming to the Court, the anticipatory bail stands rejected.

6. If the petitioner surrenders within a period of four weeks from today, the Court concerned shall take up the matter and dispose it of preferably on the same day.
