In this case, Office has recorded the following facts:

“Reg. Defect no. 3, Stamp reporter has pointed out Maintainability at S.R page kept at flag 'A' that, "The present M.J.C. petition filed U/S-482 of Cr.P.C for restoration of Criminal 3138/2014 Miscellaneous which has been dismissed for default on 26.08.2014 for non-prosecution. On going through the connected records it comes to light that aforesaid case is restored by the Honble Court by Order dated 12.11.2014 passed Miscellaneous in Criminal 43769/2014. However, by order dated
