- 2 07-04-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.
2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in Baniyapur P. S. Case No. 202 of 2023 registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.
3. As per prosecution case, 15 liters illicit liquor was recovered from behind the house of this petitioner.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no incriminating material has been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner. He has been made accused in this case only on suspicion. Recovery has been made from an open place, accessible to all. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.
5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the nature of accusation, clean



antecedent and place of recovery, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Exclusive Special Court Excise Act 1, Saran at Chapra in connection with Baniyapur P. S. Case No. 202 of 2023, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita.
