5 01-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 226 dated 11.02.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Saran along with the report of SHO, Masrakh Police Station dated 08.02.2026, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant Manoj Kumar Singh, has died. Certificate of death issued by Ward Member of Gram Panchayat Raj Kawalpura Village-Bahadurpur, P.S.-Masrakh (Saran) has also been enclosed with the said report.

2. In view of the said letter as also section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and
