2. The present petition has been preferred for the grant of following relief(s):

“for initiating contempt proceeding against the opposite parties for partly non-compliance of the order dated 21.05.2019 passed by the Hon’ble Court in CWJC No. 12586 of 2018.”

3. A show cause has come on behalf of the opposite



party no.2 and learned State counsel has taken this Court to paragraph no.3 which read as follows:

“3. That in pursuance of the aforesaid order of this Hon’ble Court, the legally payable dues, with respect to Salary, Leave Encashment and PF Account, amounting to Rs.8,20,447.00/- of the petitioners, which were supposed to be paid by the DRDA, Gaya was obtained from the Government and thereafter the same has been disbursed in the account of the petitioner.”

4. In that background, having convinced that the order stands complied and granting liberty to agitate the matter if he has still any grievance, the MJC No. 984 of 2020 is disposed of.
