9 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 495 dated 18.03.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Bhojpur, Arrah along with the report dated 18.03.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police, Jagdishpur, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Sheo Prasad Ram, is dead and the death certificate of the appellant is annexed with the said report.

In view of the said report as also section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.



3. Let the trial court record be sent back to the concerned court immediately, if not required in any other cases.
