Superintendent of Police, Bhojpur, Ara along with the Report
dated 27.04.2026 of the S.H.O, Bihiya Police Station, Bhojpur
(Ara), wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light
that the sole appellant, namely, Goga Rai @ Radhey Shyam Rai,
is dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to
Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023,
