A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioners have preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Bhadaur P.S. case No. 110 of 2025 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 103(1), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that while the informant and his grandfather were moving on the vehicle in the rally of a political party, in the meantime, on the way, the named accused persons arrived and started abusing his grandfather. When his grandfather opposed, co-accused Rajveer Singh and



Karamveer Singh took him out from his vehicle and thereafter co-accused Anant Singh fired upon him which hit on the heel of the left leg due to which he fell down. It is further alleged that co-accused Chotan Singh and Kanjay Singh, having iron rods in their hands, assaulted on his stomach, back and head and thereafter crushed him with Thar vehicle and thereafter fled away. The deceased died on the way to the hospital.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. It has further been submitted that the petitioners are not named in the FIR, and their names have surfaced only during the course of investigation being a member of mob. It has further been submitted that the assailant of the deceased Anant Singh @ Anant Kumar Singh has been granted the privilege of bail by a co-ordinate bench of this Court vide order dated 19.03.2026 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 835 of 2026. Moreover, named co-accused persons, namely, Rajveer Singh and Karamveer Singh have already been granted the privilege of anticipatory bail by a co-ordinate bench of this Court vide order dated 30.03.2026 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 5212 of 2026. Lastly, it has been submitted that the petitioners have got clean criminal antecedent and are in custody since 03.11.2025.



5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioners.

6. Heard the parties and perused the record.

7. Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, let the petitioners above-named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Patna, in connection with Bhadaur P.S. Case No. 110 of 2025.

8. The application stands allowed.
