2. The present Cr. Misc. Application has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 01.09.2018 passed by learned J.M. 1st Class, Darbhanga, District Darbhanga in connection with Misc. No.326 of 2017 (arising out of C.R. No.1233 of 2010).

3. *Vide* order dated 06.04.2026 a report regarding status of case was called for, which was received *vide* Letter No.38 of 2026 dated 25.04.2026. As per the said report submitted by the learned Trial Court, the above noted case has



already been disposed of as both the parties have compromised the matter.

4. In view of the aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that this case may be disposed of as it has become infructuous.
