3 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 856 dated 03.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Rohtas along with the report dated 01.05.2026 of the Additional Sub-Inspector of Police, Suryapur P.S., Rohtas, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that all the four appellants, namely, Jomi Dusadh, Babuni Dusadh, Ramjee Chamar @ Ramjee Ram and Nanhak Chamar @ Nanhak Ram, are dead and the death certificates of the appellants are annexed with the said report.

2. In view of the said report as also section 394 of the



Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.

3. Let the trial court record be sent back to the concerned court immediately, if not required in any other cases.
