4 01-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 206 dated 12.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Araria along with the report of Police Sub Inspector, Bhargama Police Station dated 08.02.2026, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant Hari Yadav, has died. Certificate of death issued by Sarpanch of Block-Bhargama, District-Araria has also been enclosed with the said report.
