Counsel for the parties jointly submit that the order of this Court dated 10.10.2018 passed in CWJC No. 17820 of 2018 has already stood complied with inasmuch as the father of the petitioner namely Late Ram Swaroop Prasad has been absorbed on the post of Lecturer in the Department of Psychology in R.L.S.Y. College, Aurangabad with effect from 09.05.1988 with consequential benefits, however it has been



stated that payment shall be made after the funds are made available by the State Government.

2. At this juncture, the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner be granted liberty to agitate his grievances with regard to payment of the consequential benefits, by taking recourse to the due process of law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
