Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna along with the Report
dated 10.02.2026 of the Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O, Khusrupur
Police Station, Patna, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry
it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Sidheshwar
Paswan, is dead.

2. In view of the said letters as also Section 394 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to
Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023,
since no near relative has filed any application for leave to
continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and
disposed of.
