2. The present Cr. Misc. Application has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing the F.I.R. bearing Akbarpur P.S. Case No.106 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 448, 354/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. *Vide* order dated 06.04.2026 a report regarding status of case was called for, which was received *vide* Letter No.04 dated 18.04.2026. As per the said report submitted by the learned Trial Court, the above noted case has already been disposed on 08.12.2021.
