4 11-05-2026 Perused the Memo No. 1369 dated 04.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Aurangabad along with the Report dated 02.05.2026 of the Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O., Barun Police Station as well as the Certificate of Death dated 05.08.2026 of the Mukhiya, Gram Panchayat-Kanchanpur, Aurangabad; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Ram Lal Mahto, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
