3 17-04-2026 Perused the Letter No. 725 dated 06.03.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna along with the Report dated 26.02.2026 of S.H.O, Nadi Police Station, Patna and the Report of the Ward Councilor of Ward No. 04 of Municipal Corporation, Fathua, Patna; wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Nanhaki Paswan @ Tusa, is dead.

In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.



3. Let the trial court record be sent back to the concerned court immediately, if not required in any other cases.
