3 07-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 1059 dated 03.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Bhojpur, Ara along with the Report dated 01.05.2026 of the S.H.O, Bihia Police Station, Bhojpur, Ara, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Surya Nath Yadav, is dead.
