3 14-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 1020, dated 10.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, East Champaran along with the Report dated 08.05.2026 of Sub-Inspector of Police, Sikarganj Police Station, Motihari as well as the Report dated 09.05.2026 of the Sarpanch of Gram Kachhari Kapurpakri, Prakhand-Chiraiya, East Champaran, wherein it is indicated that both the appellants, namely, Lallan Singh and Bhusan Rai, are dead.

2. In view of the said letters as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and
