3 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 560 dated 04.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Khagaria along with the Report dated 03.05.2026 of the Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O, Parbatta Police Station, Khagaria, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Ram Briksh Singh, is dead.
