APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for bail in connection with Chakia P.S. Case No.229 of 2025 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 103(1), 80, 61(2) and 3(5) of the BNS.

3. The case of the prosecution, in short, is that Sunita Devi (deceased) was married to the son of the petitioner, namely, Shivam Thakur. It is alleged that Sunita was subjected to cruelty on non-fulfillment of dowry demand and she was killed by her in-laws.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Learned counsel for the



petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is father-in-law of the deceased and he is living separately in mess and has no concern with the family affairs of the deceased or her husband. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the nature of allegation is general and omnibus. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent and he is in judicial custody since 30.11.2025.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court of learned Judicial Magistrate, First Class, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Chakia P.S. Case No.229 of 2025.
