2 15-04-2026 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

2. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this anticipatory bail application with regard to Petitioner No. 2, namely Gudu Ray.

3. Permission, as prayed for, is accorded.

4. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application with regard to Petitioner No. 2 stands dismissed as withdrawn.

5. Petitioner No. 1 apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 303(2), 109, 117(2), 74, 352 and 3(5) of the B.N.S..



6. As per prosecution case, it is alleged that Petitioner No. 1 assaulted informant with *Farsa*.

7. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. Doctor has found the injuries, allegedly caused by Petitioner No. 1, simple in nature. Petitioner claims clean antecedents.

8. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

9. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of injuries allegedly caused by Petitioner No. 1 and clean antecedents of the petitioner, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to Petitioner No. 1 is allowed.

10. Accordingly, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, let the above named Petitioner No. 1 be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Siwan in connection with Basantpur P.S. Case No. 612 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S..



11. With the aforesaid directions, this application
stands disposed of.
