5 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 583 dated 19.02.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gayaji along with the report of Police Inspector cum S.H.O., Delha Police Station, Gayaji dated 17.02.2026, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant Sudarshan Beldar @ Fatakiya has died.
