Superintendent of Police, Madhepura along with the Report
dated 28.04.2026 of the Sub-Inspector of Police, Gamharia
Police Station, Madhepura, wherein it is indicated that during
enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely,
Achchelal Sharma, is dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to
Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023,
