4 12-05-2026 Perused the Report No. 812 dated 09.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Samastipur along with the Report dated 09.05.2026 of the Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O., Kalyanpur Police Station, Samastipur as well as the Certificate of Death dated 09.05.2026 of the Ward Councilor of Ward No. 07, Municipal Corporation Samastipur; wherein it is indicated that both the appellants, namely, Yogendra Sahni @ Yogi Sahni and Rajo Sahni @ Rajba Sahni, are dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to
