ORAL ORDER

2 16-03-2026 In the instant petition, petitioner has prayed for the
following relief(s):-

“That the present writ application has been filed for issuance of appropriate writ or writs, direction or directions to the respondent authorities, particularly respondent no.2, the District Magistrate, Supaul for disposal of the application of the petitioner for grant of new arms licence for revolver/pistol (Handgun) and/or, For issuance of appropriate consequential writ or writs under the facts and circumstances of the case.”

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that despite appropriate applications having been filed before the competent authority, which is appended to the writ petition as Annexure-P/2, the arms license has not been issued by the competent au-



thority, Supaul.

3. Learned counsel for the State submits that applica-
tion under prescribed format has already been placed before the
District Magistrate, Supaul. The same may be directed to dis-
pose of by framing the timeline.

4. Considering the submission of the parties, this court
finds its appropriate to direct the District Magistrate, Supaul to
consider the claim of this petitioner for grant of arms license
within a period of four weeks from the date of fresh representa-
tion and necessary orders shall be passed in this case, in accor-
dance with law, strictly in consonance with the object of the
legislature.

4. With the above observation, the instant writ petition
stands disposed of.
