3 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 711 dated 02.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Buxar along with the report of S.H.O., Simir Police Station, Buxar dated 01.05.2026, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant Ras Bihari Pandey has died.
