3      06-05-2026                      Perused the Letter No. 450 dated 24.04.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Kaimur, Bhabua, along with the Report dated 23.04.2026 of the S.H.O., Ramgarh Police Station, Kaimur as well as the Death Certificate, which was issued by the Department of Planning and Development, Government of Bihar; wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Ram Naresh Singh, is dead.
