the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna along with the report
dated 21.04.2026 of the member of Panchayat Smiti, Kalyanpur,
wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that
the sole appellant, namely, Nageshwar Singh, is dead.

2. In view of the said report as also section 394 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to
section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023,
