7 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 764 dated 02.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Madhepura along with the report of Sub Inspector of Police, Kumarkhand Police Station, Madhepura dated 30.04.2026, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant Jagdish Yadav has died.
