3 24-04-2026 Perused the Letter No. 339 dated 12.03.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Araria along with the Report dated 10.03.2026 of the Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O, Palasi Police Station, Araria, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Ajodhi Sada @ Ayodhi Sada, is dead.
