APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for bail registered for the offence punishable under Section 310(2) of the B.N.S., 2023 and Sections 25(1-B)a, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. The case of the prosecution, in short, is that unknown miscreants who have masked their faces were armed with country-made weapons and snatched the mobile and Rs. 4,100/- from the informant and his friends. They were able to identify one of the accused, namely, Suman Mandal @ Matra.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. He also submits that the name of this petitioner is not there in the FIR;



rather, his name has surfaced during the course of investigation in the confessional statement of co-accused Nitesh Kumar. Save and except the confessional statement of the co-accused, there is nothing against the petitioner. No recovery has been made and no TIP was conducted. He further submits that the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 26.01.2026.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State and submits that the petitioner has got criminal antecedent of three cases.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail *with the conditions that the petitioner shall cooperate in the trial and shall remain physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned court below*. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in connection with Sabour P.S. Case No. 134 of 2025.
