8 13-05-2026 Perused the Report No. 816 dated 10.05.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Muzaffarpur along with the Report dated 10.05.2026 of the Inspector of Police-cum-S.H.O., Sadar Police Station, Muzaffarpur as well as the Death Certificate dated 10.02.2026 issued by the Department of Planning and Development, Government of Bihar; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Deepu Kumar Singh @ Dipu Kumar, is dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to
