2 21-04-2026 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Simari P.S. Case No. 32 of 2026, registered under Section 30(a)
of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. Recovery is of 7 litres of illicit mahua wine.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. No
incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of
the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged
recovery. The petitioner is in custody since 11.02.2026.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer
for bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case
and period of custody, this bail application is allowed.



7. Let the petitioner above named, be granted bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Simari P.S. Case No. 32 of 2026, subject to the condition that:

(i). The petitioner shall mark his attendance at Simari Police Station on every Sunday of each month. In the event of default, the bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.

8. It is made clear that any observation made herein is prima facie in nature and limited solely for the purpose of adjudication of the present bail application. Such observations shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and shall not influence the trial or any other proceedings in any manner.
