2 10-04-2026 This case has been listed for out of turn hearing as
the marriage of the petitioner is fixed for 20.04.2026.

2. Heard the parties.

3. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Baniyapur P.S. Case No. 67 of 2026 registered for the offence
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

4. The recovery is of 354.96 liters of illicit liquor
from the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and he is in custody since 18.03.2026.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is ready to donate Rs. 25,000/- in some charitable
organization without accepting his guilt.

7. Learned APP appearing for the State opposes the



prayer for bail of the petitioner.

8. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned Court below in connection with Baniyapur P.S. Case No. 67 of 2026.

9. This is also subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit an amount of Rs. 25,000/- in Ramakrishna Mission Ashram, Latu Maharaj Path, Chhapra and produce the receipt of the same before the Court below. The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted after verifying the genuineness of the receipt produced by the petitioner.

10. It is, however, clarified that the observations made herein are limited to the adjudication of the present bail application and shall not prejudice the case of the petitioner at any subsequent stage of the trial and this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
