10 13-05-2026 Perused the Report No. 1046 dated 03.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Bhojpur at Ara along with the Report dated 28.04.2026 of the Assistant Sub-Inspector of Police, Agiaon Police Station, Bhojpur as well as the Certificate of Death dated 30.04.2026 of the Sarpanch of Gram Kachhari-Agiaon, Block- Agiaon, Bhojpur; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Ritesh Kumar Singh @ Bhuwar Singh @ Ritesh Singh, is dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and
