4 13-05-2026 Perused the Report No. 708 dated 05.05.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Muzaffarpur along with the Report dated 04.05.2026 of the O.P. In-charge, Panapur O.P., Muzaffarpur as well as the Death Certificate dated 27.11.2021 issued by the Department of Planning and Development, Government of Bihar; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Umesh Giri, is dead.
