3 13-05-2026 Perused the Report No. 1218 dated 10.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Bhojpur at Ara along with the Report dated 10.05.2026 of the S.H.O., Agiaon Bazar Police Station, Bhojpur at Ara as well as the Certificate of Death dated 10.05.2026 of the Sarpanch of Gram Kachhari- Katriya, Block-Piro, Dist.- Bhojpur at Ara; wherein it is indicated that the sole appellant, namely, Jitendra Kumar Singh @ Jitendra Singh, is dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and



disposed of.
