5 06-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 443 dated 28.04.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Khagaria along with the report of Police Sub Inspector, Town Police Station, Khagaria station dated 28.04.2026, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the appellants Ramjee Mahto and Nunnulal Mahto, have died. Certificate of death issued by Nagar Parshad, Ward No. 13, Khagaria, has also been enclosed with the said report.
