2 21-04-2026 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Inarwa P.S. FIR No. 65 of 2025, registered under Sections 20(b)
(ii) (C) , 23(c), 25, 29 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

3. Recovery is of 57.880 Kg. of ganja from a bolero
vehicle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. The
petitioner has one criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
18.05.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer
for bail.

6. Considering the huge quantity of recovery of ganja,
this bail application is dismissed.



7. The trial court is directed to expedite the trial of the petitioner and conclude the same at the earliest.

8. It is made clear that any observation made herein is *prima facie* in nature and limited solely for the purpose of adjudication of the present bail application. Such observations shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and shall not influence the trial or any other proceedings in any manner.
