2 10-04-2026 Following is the relief sought for in the present writ application:-

"(a) For quashing of the decision of Technical Bid Tender Committee contained in Memo No.344 dated 30.03.2026 (Ann. 5) related to N.I.T. No.- Re-tender No.-RRSMP 08/2025-26 to extent whereby it has been decided to go for re-tender.

(b) For a direction to the concerned authority to conclude the process of N.I.T. No.-Re-tender No.-RRSMP-08/2025-26 (Package No.- RRSMP/25-26



SIWAN -1/06 and award contract to the petitioner who is lowest bidder in the fact and circumstances of the case.

(c) For a direction to restrain the respondents from giving effect to decision contained in Memo No.344 dated 30.03.2026 during pendency of the present writ application and/or without the leave of this Hon'ble Court.

(d) For any other relief/reliefs for which the petitioner is entitled to and your lordship may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice."

2. Mr. Shekhar Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to submit a representation before the competent authority for redressal of his grievance.

3. Permission is accorded.

4. In case such a representation is filed, the competent authority shall consider and dispose of the same in accordance with law.

5. With the aforesaid observation, the present writ application stands disposed of.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
