4 11-05-2026 Perused the Letter No.655 dated 04.05.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Vaishali along with the Report dated 01.05.2026 of SHO, Chandpura Police Station as well as the Report dated 01.05.2026 of the Sarpanch of Gram Kachahari, Rasulpur, Habib, Desari, Vaishali wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the appellant, namely, Ramesh Sah, is dead.

2. In view of the said letters as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to



continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.

3. Let the trial court record be sent back to the concerned court immediately, if not required in any other cases.
