7 08-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 823 dated 03.05.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Saran at Chapra along with the report dated 02.05.2026 of the Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O., Muffasil P.S., Saran at Chapra, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry, it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Hira Manjhi, is dead and the death certificate of the appellant is annexed with the said report.

In view of the said report as also section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to section 435 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.



3. Let the trial court record be sent back to the concerned court immediately, if not required in any other cases.
