4 05-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 256 dated 24.04.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Sheikhpura along with the report of Police Inspector cum SHO, Chewda Police Station, Sheikhpura dated 24.04.2026, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant Harbans Yadav, has died. Certificate of death issued by Mukhiya of Gram Panchayat Raj, Ekrama, Sheikhpura has also been enclosed with the said report.

In view of the said letter as also section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to continue the appeal, the Criminal Appeal stands abated and disposed of.
