4 19-03-2026 Perused the Letter No.87 dated 09.02.2026 of the Superintendent of Police, Sheikhpura along with the Report No. 123 dated 04.02.2026 of SHO, Mahuli Police Station, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Chuhan Chaudhary, is died.
